

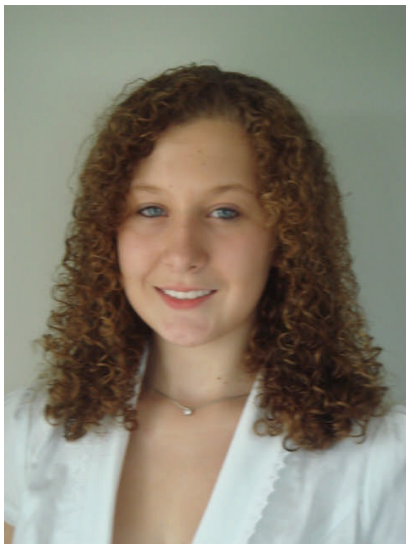
Zonta Club of Geneva Announces 2009 Scholarships
